Last weekend, with the help of 30 people, they built 300-feet of new trail heading east from the 22nd Street tower.

This section is part of XTERRA's annual off-road triathlon and trail running races, which will be held for the 17th straight year in Richmond this June 13-14. The new section will eliminate the need for runners to come-up to Riverside Drive, and make some of the best trails on the XTERRA World Tour even better.
