### Belle Island Pump Track

The club and park system are still looking for any individuals or clubs experienced in maintaining this type of structure to head up this continuous maintenance effort. Maintenance of this track will require about one dedicated workday per month which will be factored into the fall/winter maintenance schedule.

## Belle Island Progressive Bike Ramps

Following up on last month's news about the progressive bike ramp project on Belle Island, a design of the layout is in process and we anticipate movement on this in the next few months.

#### Trail Work

The park is \*considering\* making **certain** trails (Poop Loop, Dogwood Dell) directional or alternating the days of the week that the trails would be ridden clockwise or counter clockwise. We would like to hear people's thoughts on this. Anyone?

# Slave Trail/Ancarrow's East (aliases: Poop Loop, Polo)

If you've ridden the Slave Trail to the Poop Loop lately, you may have noticed a re-route off of the Slave Trail onto some sweet, bike specific singletrack. This reroute is intended to provide bikers with their own dedicated access to the Poop Loop and eliminate the possibilities of multiuser mishaps on the Slave Trail, which is heavily populated by hikers, fishermen and folks utilizing the Ancarrow's Landing parking lot. At present, the re-route does not yet extend

entirely to the entrance to the Slave Trail under the I-95 bridge, but it does eliminate a good portion of the Slave Trail. The plan is to finish that project during the fall/winter trail work days. If you're unfamiliar with this reroute, keep an eye out for the entrance points which are marked with the yellow trail markers. (The first entrance, if traveling east from the I-95 bridge, is just across from the cement slab that will pitch you into the river if you're not paying attention.)
